Managing our differences

A spectrum of personality types exists in any parish and we'd better be aware of it if we intend working in the church. Such is the advice of Sr Karen Kent, Cork and Ross coordinator of parish development.

Among the types she depicted were the "do-er", the "should-er", the "express train-er", the "clown", the "negative-izer", the "gather-er", the "quiet one", the "strong determined", and the "ideas person". There's a place for each one but each must be managed.

The "doer" just does it. If it's tea you want, he's your man. The "should" person will tell you how a job should really be done. The express person will be out of the blocks immediately but will end up alone. The clown entertains, the laugh comes before all else.

Everything is wrong or inadequate for the negative person. Things are black if bad and grey is about as good as it gets. The gatherer collects every scrap of information, hoards it and releases it sparingly. The ideas

person is the opposite to the doer. As an example, Garret Fitzgerald is reputed to have said, "it works in practice but does it work in theory?"

The quiet person is quiet, listens a lot and needs a lot of listening! The strong person steam-rolls everyone and then wonders where everyone is gone.

Each one has his or her strengths and weaknesses. The key is to know we are different, accept it and manage our differences. Apparently, if we can do that we'll have a fantastic group because it will be self propelling and self regulating. Add a dash of prayer and a splash of the Holy Spirit and the parish should be in good hands.
