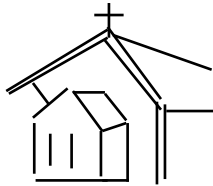

RCIA Group (Glanmire Parish)

The Lenten Season is a very important time for those participating in the RCIA (Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults), even though we in Glanmire parish do not have any Adults presenting themselves for the rite of Initiation we do have three families with children and teenagers preparing to receive the sacraments of Initiation; Baptism, Eucharist (First Holy Communion) and Confirmation. Our Parish RCIA group have been meeting with these candidates every two weeks since September last year.

Last Christmas three siblings from one of our families joyously had their First Confession (Sacrament of Reconciliation) and their First Holy Communion. Over the next few weeks others will receive the Sacrament of Baptism, Reconciliation and First Holy Communion, either in preparation to receive another

sacrament with their class mates in their various schools. Finally two of our young people will receive the sacrament of Confirmation at the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday Night on April 4th.

We would ask all in our parish to please pray for these children and teenagers and all our young people in our parish who are preparing to receive the sacrament over the next coming weeks and months.
