Missionary Sisters of St Columban

Each year, Bishop Buckley gives permission to one missionary group to make an appeal throughout the Diocese to support its own particular missionary projects. This year it is the turn of the Columban Sisters and, on their behalf, Sr Mary Nolan will speak at all masses in Glanmire Parish next weekend, 30-31 May.

The Columban Sisters were founded in Ireland 93 years ago to help with the evangelisation of China. Since then, they have spread to many other countries where they work to bring the gospel of Christ. As well as working in Ireland and America, the Sisters have mission commitments in Peru, Chile, Pakistan, Burma (Myanmar), the Philippines, Korea and Hong Kong.

The Sisters take inspiration from their patron, the sixth-century Irish monk

St Columban who undertook a mission to mainland Europe which was amazingly successful. The Sisters are sustained and nourished by a spirituality which springs from contemplation and moves them to prophetic action and dialogue.

Since their foundation, the Columban Sisters have changed and adapted to new situations. At first they established education and medical institutions. Then in the late 1970s they moved towards less structured ministries. Today, they work at building "basic christian communities," family catechesis, retreats and spiritual direction, pastoral counselling and faith formation.

We extend a warm welcome to Sr Mary Nolan and look forward to hearing her message on behalf of the Missionary Sisters of St Columban.
