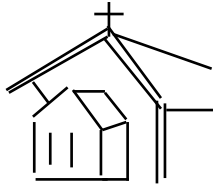

Ordination: Glanmire Connection

Eamonn Roche, who lived in Glanmire Court for a number of years before entering the seminary at Maynooth in 2009, will be ordained to the priesthood on Sunday 5th July in St Colman's Cathedral, Cobh. The ceremony begins at 2.30 pm and will be celebrated by the bishop of Cloyne, Dr William Crean. Eamonn worked as an engineer before taking up the call to priesthood. He was also very involved in Youth 2000, a renewal movement for young people, inspired by St John Paul II. He will serve in the diocese of Cloyne. The new Fr Eamonn Roche will come to Glanmire later in the summer to celebrate Mass.

Eamonn is one of 12 students being ordained to the priesthood this summer on completing their preparation in Maynooth. This is a source of great joy but one that is tempered by the fact that these new priests come from 11 dioceses out of a total of 26. Cork and Ross is not one of the eleven dioceses but we did have two priests ordained in 2014: Fr Ben Hodnett, now curate in Frankfield, Douglas and Fr Marius O'Reilly, who is chaplain in UCC.

From 1st July there will be no Mass in St Michael's Thurs & Fri for the month's of July and August except 1st Friday's.
