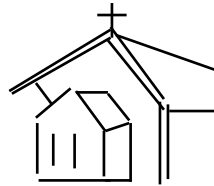

## Do This In Memory

Last weekend we celebrated the Enrolment of our children, from the primary schools of New Inn, St Joseph's and St Michael's for this year's Do This In Memory programme. As we begin this year's programme it may be beneficial to explain why we embark on this programme every year. The Do This In Memory complements the school-based work and takes place outside the classroom in the context of the parish Sunday Eucharist. It is then continued in the home through the participation of the parents helping the children through various activities and resources.

This highlights the importance of the Sunday Eucharist as a celebration where we gather as a community, to be nourished by the Word (Readings) and the Bread of Life (Eucharist), and are sent forth to live the Gospel (Mission). It also acknowledges the home as the most important and significant place where the faith of our children is nurtured, nourished and sustained.

In our parish we have a group of parents from each school who work with the priests, teachers and other parents to organise the Do This In Memory Masses throughout the coming months. Another group that is very important to this

programme is our community who gathers for the Sunday Eucharist, we ask you to pray and show support for our children as they prepare to fully participate in their First Eucharist (First Holy Communion). A sense of welcome and of belonging is most important both for our children but also for their parents. So please welcome all with a smile.
