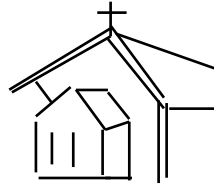

## Jesus goes into the village of Nain

Lord, so often we write off people – alcoholics and drug addicts; delinquent children; vagrants and those we call unemployable.

We thank you for the times that you sent Jesus into our town accompanied by his disciples and a large number of people: Alcoholics Anonymous; the Vincent de Paul Society; communities such as L'Arche, Emmanuel, Living Water and Zion communities; those who work in rehabilitation centers. Strong in their compassion they made us stand still, got those whom we were taking out for burial to stand up and begin to

speak for themselves, and gave them back to their mothers so that we were filled with awe and praised you for having visited your people.

Lord, there is a lot of despair in many countries today. There was a time when these people dreamt of better days and a new world they would create. Today, like the widow in the gospel story, they are seeing these dreams being carried out for burial. We pray that your Church, like Jesus, may feel compassion for these people and give them back their hopes for a glorious future.

Lord, we sometimes feel that the Church is losing its influence in the world and we conclude that we need more TV programs, more learned teaching, or more organizations. But if people see the Church living the story of Jesus, going into towns, feeling compassion for those who mourn, telling them not to cry, and giving them back their reason for living, then they will be filled with awe, they will know that a great prophet has appeared among them, and this opinion of the Church will spread throughout the towns and all over the countryside.
