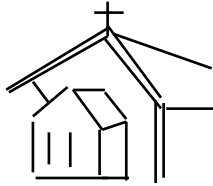

## Candle in the Wind

The wedding of Princess Diana (Diana Spencer), in 1981, was watched by 750 million people. Her funeral in 1997 was viewed by 2.5 billion people. At her funeral, singer Elton John brought tears to the eyes of hundreds of mourners in Westminster Abbey when he sang: "Candle in the Wind." Interestingly, this song – with the line "Goodbye, Norma Rose" – was originally written for an equally glamorous woman, Norma Jeane, who assumed the stage name 'Marilyn Monroe' and died on 5 August 1962, due to an overdose of sleeping pills. Diana and Marilyn share many things in common – both were beautiful and wealthy, photographed by paparazzi

worldwide, yet, unhappy in relationships, and both died tragically in August aged but 36 – young icons snuffed out like candles in the wind.
