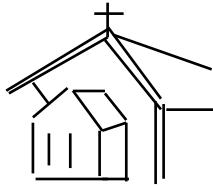

Miraculous rescue of Jessica McClure

For two days in October of 1987, not just a community, not just a county, not just a nation, but the entire world was watching with bated breath the drama of an eighteen-month-old little girl named Jessica McClure who had fallen twenty-two feet through an eight-inch opening in an oil pipeline at a daycare centre. For fifty-eight solid hours over two and a half days, drilling experts, highway construction equipment, pneumatic drills, special air vents, high pressure hydraulic drills, were expended in an unbelievable Herculean effort to rescue this one little girl. When she was finally pulled from that hole, an entire world cheered. The drama of Baby Jessica's being lost and found touched hearts worldwide. Every parent hugged his/her own child a little tighter.
