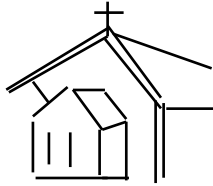

Expressing our gratitude

In 1976 Louise Fletcher was awarded an Oscar for best actress for her role as Nurse Ratched in the movie *One Flew Over the Cuckoo's Nest*. Her presentation of the chillingly prim psychiatric ward administrator is ranked by the American Film Institute as one of the five greatest screen villains of all time. She had given up acting for eleven years to raise her children before she won that role after five big-name actresses had turned it down. In accepting her Academy Award, Louise Fletcher did a very dramatic thing. With her voice breaking with emotion she faced the camera. Many in the audience must have wondered what was happening as, in a first for the Oscars, she moved into sign language in order to communicate directly with her parents. She said: "For my mother and my father, I want to say thank you for teaching me to have a dream. You are seeing my dream come true."

Louise Fletcher delivered the message in sign language, because both of her parents were deaf mutes and were watching from their home in Alabama.
