### Da Vinci's Lesson

Leonardo da Vinci painted "The Last Supper" mural in the refectory of the Convent of Santa Maria delle Grazie in Milan taking three years to do so. The story goes that the Prior from the monastery complained to da Vinci about the long delay. Da Vinci was enraged and wrote to the head of the monastery, explaining he had been struggling to find the perfect villainous face for Judas, and that he had at last found it in the features of the Prior who complained. While painting the picture, he took delight in knowing that others would actually notice the face of the Prior on Judas. Judas is wearing green and blue and is in shadow, looking rather withdrawn. He is clutching a small bag, a reference to his role within the 12 disciples as treasurer. He is

also tipping over the salt cellar. This may be related to the near-Eastern expression to "betray the salt" meaning to betray one's Master. As Da Vinci worked on the faces of the other disciples, he often tried to paint the face of Jesus but couldn't make any progress. Da Vinci felt frustrated and confused. In time, he realized what was wrong. His belittling of the Prior was stopping him from finishing the face of Jesus. Only after making peace with the Prior who complained and repainting the face of Judas was he able to paint the face of Jesus and complete his masterpiece. Mary Shelly would later describe that face of Jesus as "majesty and love joined to an absence of all guile."
