

Name the last five winners of the Miss Universe Pageant. Do you know all these answers? Probably not. Ask yourself some additional questions: 1. Who fed and clothed you when you were helpless? 2. What was the name of your first class teacher? 3. Who is the first friend you would call in an emergency? You do know the answers to these questions. They are the salt and light of the world.

The story of the Eternal Word Television Network [EWTN] is the story of a brave woman who had the courage of her conviction that she should be the salt of the earth and the light of the world. Mother Angelica, who died last

year, started broadcasting Catholic TV for just a few hours a day in 1981 from the garage of her Poor Clare Monastery in the US. The project grew and grew, and now, after thirty-five years, EWTN is available twenty-four hours a day all over the world by cable and satellite. Mother Angelica kept putting her lamp on the lamp-stand so that Christ's Light would shine for everyone in the modern global village.
