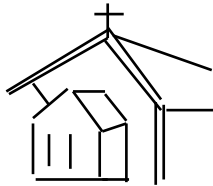

Friday 3rd March is a dedicated Day of Prayer for survivors and victims of clerical sexual abuse, in Ireland and around the world, as requested by Pope Francis. During the month of March, representatives from a support service for survivors called Towards Peace, will be present and speaking at Masses here in Cork and Ross. They look forward to speaking with us in Glanmire, the 11/12th March. Here is more information about Towards Peace:

Towards Peace is a new spiritual support service designed for those who have experienced sexual, physical, emotional or spiritual abuse by Catholic Church personnel in Ireland. Support is also available for family members of abuse survivors. The vision of Towards Peace is to provide a safe supportive space, where people who have been affected by abuse in a Church context can be accompanied as they seek their own experience of spiritual peace, one step at a time. Towards Peace provides spiritual support through one-to-one spiritual direction sessions, with a qualified spiritual companion. Up to nine sessions are
