Members of *Viatores Christi* will speak at Masses in Glanmire this weekend.

Viatores Christi (VC) is an Irish-based development organisation supporting and working within the faith-based international development sector. First established as a Lay Missionary Association, under the Catholic Church in Ireland in 1960, today, VC works with over 30 partners across a wider range of sectors in Africa, Asia, Latin America and the Caribbean. VC works with its partners to identify and address clearly defined needs ensuring that the root causes of poverty within communities are addressed, and real and sustainable futures sought for the projects' beneficiaries. VC addresses these needs through through clearly defined development interventions and when needed through the recruitment, training and placement of highly-skilled long-term volunteers.

Why are they talking at mass? They are talking for a number of reasons. First, they want to raise awareness about the missionary work of the Church and the role of lay missionaries, both at home and overseas. Second, to thank the people of the Cork and Ross Diocese for their support over the years. Third, to offer an opportunity and preparation to anyone who feels called to volunteer their time, skills and talents. And fourth, to appeal for ongoing help both financial and through prayer.
