There is a familiar anecdote in the life of St. John Maria Vianney, the "Cure D'Ars." He used to notice a peasant standing in front of the tabernacle in the village church every morning on his way for farm work. One day he asked him, "What do you do here every morning?" The man answered very simply: "I look at God and God looks at me." The Cure D'Ars liked to repeat this story: "He looked at God and God looked at him: this says everything about genuine prayer, my children!"
