Annual mass at Rathcooney cemetery

On Tuesday, 4th July 2017, the annual remembrance mass was celebrated at Rathcooney Cemetery by Fr. John Newman. The evening was overcast but remained dry for the celebration of mass. There was a large attendance including many for our neighbouring parishes.

This event is organised by the parish assembly but with lots of help from others. The altar was transported from the parish rooms in Glanmire to and from Rathcooney. It was then placed in front of the large cross in the graveyard under an awning. The altar society provided lovely flower arrangements and created further arrangements on the night from flowers brought along by others.

A sound system is set up every year by Finbarr and allows for people to hear the mass while remaining at family graves in any part of the graveyard, including the section across the road. Before and after mass music was piped through this system.

The mass at Rathcooney is a wonderfully commemorative mass which remembers and celebrates the lives of our loved ones buried at Rathcooney and in other cemeteries. A choir accompanied by a guitar added to the very prayerful atmosphere. As part of the mass, Fr Newman blessed the graveyard and the large congregation present.

Thanks to the County Council, the organising committee, Finbarr for the sound, the altar society, the readers, choir, cantor, ministers of the Eucharist, Fr Newman and the many other people who helped make this annual mass successful.

Sick: If a person is sick at home or house bound and would like a visit from the priest, contact the parish office to arrange.



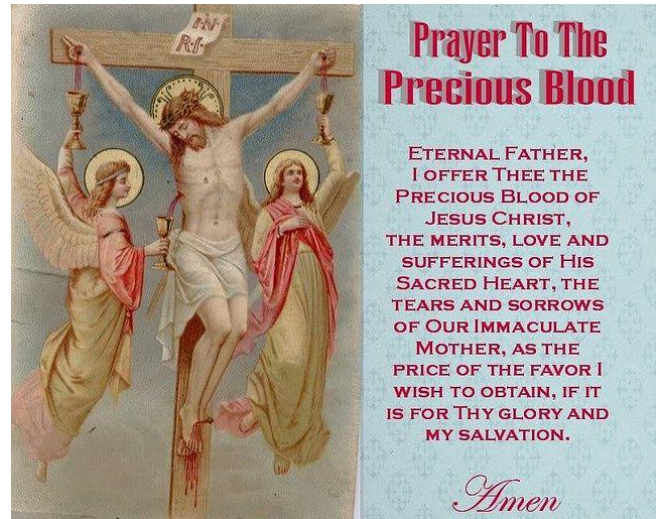
St Vincent de Paul
