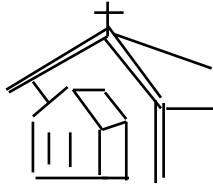

In the recent clerical changes, Bishop John Buckley, Bishop of Cork and Ross, reassigned Fr Michael Anthony Buckley “to be CC Schull /Goleen / Muintir Bhaire”. The new appointment is effective from the 1st of September 2017.

Fr Anthony took up his appointment as curate here in Glanmire/ Glounthaune on the 12th of August last year having spent the previous year as chaplain to the Mercy Hospital. Fr Anthony's time here was all too brief. Parishioners of Glanmire have had little time to get to know him. During the short time he was here, he showed exceptional regard for the Mass which he celebrated with reverence. His well prepared liturgies were enhanced by his fine singing voice. His attentiveness to the proper celebration of the sacraments, to his clerical attire, and to his bearing as a priest were

exemplary. In particular, the school children liked Fr Anthony greatly and he in turn regaled them with songs and stories.
