"Size up the salary"

If you want to get people upset very quickly in today's world, all you have to do is begin talking about salaries. We often play the game of comparing our salary to someone else's salary. It is called "size up the salary." When we play that game, we usually compare our wages with a person who is making more money than we are. They are making more money, and they seem to have less skill and education. Then we become upset, but we usually don't say anything, just simmer inside. That is the way we normally play the "size up the salary" game. We see resonances of this in the recent debate about unequal salaries for equal work. Women simply want equal pay for equal work. Money, salaries, equal pay for equal work, affirmative action: these words cause all kinds of tensions within us. It is with this tense and conflicted mood that we approach Jesus' parable for today. Today's Gospel presents a group of farm workers playing that game and judging the

generosity of the land-owner unjust and unfair. And this has a profound effect on our image of God.
