Season of Advent

Time flies along and here we are again at the beginning of Advent, the season that is a preparation for the coming of Jesus at Christmas. But it is much more than preparing for Christmas. It picks up our experience of waiting in hope. We wait for answers from God, for greater closeness in prayer, for an end to injustice and war, for recovery from illness, for the bright vision of God to replace the darkness of faith. Christmas will celebrate Jesus being born among us. Advent relates to Jesus still in the womb. While we wait, we celebrate a season of hope.

The First Sunday of Advent

Priest: Today is the First Sunday of Advent, the Sunday of Hope.

Reader: Our hope is in God and in his Son, Jesus Christ. He is the one appointed by God to be judge of all things. He is the one through whom God has promised to save and redeem his people.

Priest: We light the first candle today to remind us that Jesus is our hope and the hope of the world.

The first candle of the Advent Wreath is lit.

All: Let us pray – O God of Hope, Emmanuel, God with us, we pray that you may send your light into our hearts at this time. Help us to be ready for the day and the hour of Christ's final appearing. By the power of the Holy Spirit, transform us, so that our worship, our celebration, our time of preparation may be pleasing to you both now and forever more. Amen.
