Living Trinitarian love: three insights

St Augustine said, "Where there is love, there is the Trinity". He gave the "analogy of love" with Father—Son—Spirit as Lover, Beloved, and Love flowing between them, respectively. Pope Benedict XVI in *Deus Caritas Est* (2005): "God is love, and he who abides in love abides in God, and God abides in him" (1 John 4:16). These words from the First Letter of John express with remarkable clarity the heart of the Christian faith: the Christian image of God and the resulting image of humankind and its destiny. In the same verse, St John also offers a summary of Christian life: "We have come to know and to believe in the love God has for us". Pope Francis in *Amoris Laetitia* (2016): "The ability of human couples to beget life is the path along which the history of salvation progresses. Seen this way, the couple's fruitful relationship becomes an image for understanding and describing the mystery of God himself, for in the Christian vision of the Trinity, God is contemplated as Father, Son and Spirit of love. The Triune God is a communion of love, and the family is its living reflection."
