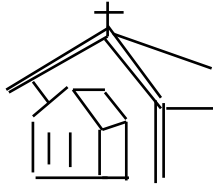

Child Safeguarding

The parish of Glanmire recognises and upholds the dignity and rights of children and is committed to ensuring their safety and well-being. We recognise each child as a gift from God and we value and encourage the participation of children in all activities in the parish that enhance their spiritual, physical, emotional, intellectual and social development. In fact, all Church personnel (clergy, religious, staff, volunteers) have a responsibility to safeguard children through promoting their welfare and developing a safe and caring environment that supports their best interests and prevents abuse.

At next weekend masses (February 22-23), members of the parish child safeguarding team will give a short talk outlining the up-to-date protocols and legal requirements that are in place. An open meeting in the Parish Center to further clarify issues and answer questions will take place on Monday 24 February at 8pm. Those who are expected to attend include leaders of children's choirs, altar-servers co-ordinators, Ministers of the Eucharist, sacristans, Pastoral Assembly members, clergy, and anyone who deals with children in any way in the parish.

Stations of the Cross

The Stations of the Cross will be celebrated in St Joseph's Church each Wednesday of Lent at 7.30pm, beginning on Ash Wednesday, 26th February - ashes will be distributed that evening. This is a time honoured devotion and will help us identify with Christ Jesus on his suffering way and redemptive passion. Lay volunteers will lead the Stations which should take about forty minutes. It is hoped to "walk the Stations" outdoors on some Wednesdays, weather depending.

Young Adults 18-15 are invited to join the Diocesan Pilgrimage to Lourdes as helpers to the sick and disabled. The pilgrimage will be led by Bishop Fintan Gavin and will travel from Cork from 12th to 17th June 2020. As a young adult helper you will be assisting with the sick in the hospital in the wards, kitchen or dining room, pushing wheelchairs to and from liturgies and Mass, participating yourself in all the Masses and ceremonies of the pilgrimage, accompanying the sick and disabled in social time.
