Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes and Sacrament of Anointing

On 11th February 1858, Our Lady first appeared to the fourteen-year-old Bernadette Soubirous. Later Bernadette was to learn that the mysterious lady was the Blessed Virgin and to hear from her lips, "I am the Immaculate Conception". In 1992 Pope Saint John Paul II instituted the World Day of the Sick to be held on the commemoration of Our Lady of Lourdes.

Here in Glanmire, on the Feast of Our Lady of Lourdes we pray for healing and strength especially for the sick and vulnerable. The sacrament of the Anointing of the Sick will be celebrated in St Joseph's Church at the 10am Mass. Remember, you don't have to be "on your last legs" to receive the sacrament of God's healing. Anyone who desires to be strengthened and consoled by God's gracious healing should simply go to the priest and invite God's healing action to work in your life.

The sacrament is carried out with anointing oil and prayer. The oil is first rubbed onto the forehead with the words: "Through this holy anointing may the Lord in his love and mercy help you with the grace of the Holy Spirit." Amen. Then, the priest rubs the oil onto the palms of the hands, saying: "May the Lord who frees you from sin save you and raise you up." Amen.

Stations of the Cross

The Stations of the Cross will be held in St Joseph Church each Wednesday of Lent at 7.30pm, beginning on Ash Wednesday, 26th February. Ashes will be distributed after the Stations. This is a time honoured devotion and will help us identify with Christ Jesus on his suffering way and redemptive passion. There is a very fine set of Stations in the church to help focus our prayer.
