

Offertory Envelopes



Christmas Masses

There will be nine masses celebrated in Glanmire Parish at Christmas, six in St Joseph's Church and three in St Michael's Church, as follows:

The maximum number of people allowed in a church is a pod of **50 people which includes priests and stewards**. To comply with government and church guidelines, we are putting a structure in place for the Christmas masses to ensure fairness for people wishing to attend. This includes

- Everyone must make a reservation to attend mass.
- You may reserve a seat for yourself and your family. You can only reserve seats for your immediate family.
 In fairness to all, you cannot book seats for other families, neighbours etc.
- Reservations will take place after masses on Saturday 6th and Sunday 7th, December.
- A contact telephone number will be made available on the parish website and other social media outlets next week to deal with queries and issues.
- To make a reservation you will have to give your name, telephone number, contact details, your mass preference and the names of those who will attending with you.
- Later in December, you will receive a text to confirm your booking and mass time. Please bear in mind you may not get your preferred mass time.
- Unfortunately, there can be no walk-ups allowed at the Christmas Eve and Christmas Day masses.
- It is not possible to accommodate everyone and we ask for your understanding.
- All masses in St Joseph's Church will be streamed live. You can access any of the masses through the parish website [glanmireparish.ie] and we encourage people to use this facility.
- Again, we apologise for any inconvenience caused. But do remember Christmas masses will be celebrated every day until the Feast of the Epiphany on January 6.
