#### Invasion of Ukraine

As we go to print (Thursday morning), Vladimir Putin has ordered Russian troops into Ukraine. Pope Francis today spoke of his concern at the situation: "My heart aches greatly at the worsening situation in Ukraine. Despite the diplomatic efforts of the last few weeks, increasingly alarming scenarios are opening up. Like me, many people all over the world are feeling anguish and concern. Once again the peace of all is threatened by partisan interests." We keep the people of Ukraine in our prayers. There is a sizeable community of Ukrainans in Cork and we empathise with them in their anguish.

#### **Temperance Sunday**

This Sunday, 27th February, is Temperance Sunday. Across Cork and Ross, hundreds of people will take a pledge to abstain from gambling, alcohol and illicit drugs to get their lives back on line. May God strengthen us all in our efforts at moderation.

The Season of Lent begins on Ash Wednesday which falls on 2nd March. There will be 10am mass in St Joseph's and 11am mass in St Michael's. Signing with ashes will be done at these masses. Ashes will be available at both churches after mass. Those who want to attend an evening mass can do so at Little Island Church where mass will be celebrated at 7pm. Signing with ashes will take place at that mass.
