With particular care he explained the great masterpieces of art, sculpture and architecture. He finally concluded at the Blessed Sacrament Chapel trying his best to explain quickly what it was. As the group dispersed, an elderly man, who had been particularly attentive stayed behind, and said, "Pardon me. Would you explain again this 'Blessed Sacrament?" Our student did, after which the man exclaimed, "Ah, if this is so, what is in this chapel is a greater work of art than anything else in this basilica."

The Second Collection this weekend is for Peter's Pence, the proceeds of which are used by Pope Francis for philanthropic works throughout the world and for administrative costs of the Vatican state.

Restructure Parish Communities

Next Sunday, priests and four members of the laity of Glanmire parish will go to Rochestown Park Hotel with Bishop of Cork and Ross, Fintan Gavin, and other members of the Diocese, to discuss how we can best restructure our parish communities. Following this meeting, Bishop will meet with priests in the early weeks of July to make clerical changes. These new appointments will then be taken up at the beginning of September. This is a stressful time for priests and keep them in your prayer.

Church Painting

The painting of St Joseph's Church - inside and outside - is now complete. The presbytery has also been freshly painted. The work was carried out by Liam Cotter Decorators Ltd, a local company. The cost of the painting is €73,500 in total: the presbytery €8,500; Church (outside) €25,000; Church (inside) €38,000. These figures are inclusive of VAT. Work on the lights is still ongoing. LED lights have been installed throughout the church. Ventilation of the church has been greatly enhanced by the instillation of twenty-two air vents. We rely on your donations and contributions to pay for these works.
