Courage

In the 1920s, an English adventurer named Mallory led an expedition to conquer Mount Everest. His first, second, and even his third attempt with an experienced team met with failure. Upon his return to England, the few who had survived held a banquet to salute Mallory and those who had perished. As he stood up to speak, Mallory looked around at pictures of himself and those who had died. Then he turned his back on the crowd and faced a large picture of Mount Everest looming large like an unbeatable giant. With tears streaming down his face, he spoke to the mountain on behalf of his dead friends: "I speak to you Mount Everest, in the name of all brave men living, and those yet unborn. New Families of Parishes

Bishop Gavin has restructured the Diocese into sixteen groups of parishes, called "families of parishes." The number of parishes in each "family" will vary but usually will contain four to six parishes. With regard to this area, Glanmire is linked with Glountaune, Watergrasshill and Carraig na bhFear. Fr John Newman is transferred from Glanmire to Bandon and Fr Donal Cotter is going from Watergrasshill to Dennehy's Cross. The four parishes will have five priests, four co-PPs and a curate. Fr Pat Fogarty will live in Glanmire; Fr Damien O'Mahony will live in Glounthaune; Fr Christy Fitzgerald will live in Watergrasshill; Fr Martin Keohane will live in Carraig na bhFear; and Fr Pat Nugent will continue to live in the Presbytery in Glanmire. Fr Christy Fitzgerald is the "moderator". It will be his responsibility to make sure the "Family of Parishes" run smoothly. Of course, it will take quite a while for this new system to be established. Let's hope and pray that all goes well.
