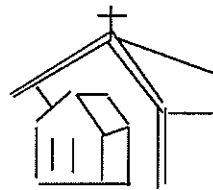

## Season of Creation: 1<sup>st</sup> September – 4<sup>th</sup> October 2022

### *“Listen to the Voice of Creation”*

The Season of Creation has a special significance for the Catholic Church, particularly since Pope Francis established the 1<sup>st</sup> September as an annual World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation.

The Season of Creation celebrates the joy of creation in addition to encouraging awareness-raising initiatives to protect the environment.

*Listen to the Voice of Creation!*

The theme for the Season of Creation this year is *“Listen to the Voice of Creation”*.

*“I have heard their cry ... I know their sufferings ... Come, now! I will send you .... I will be with you.”* (Book of Exodus 3: 1-12)

Because *“It cannot be emphasised enough how everything is interconnected”* (Laudato Si)

- We are called to listen to the call of creation, to the voices of those who suffer the impacts of climate change, to the voices of those who hold generational wisdom about how to live gratefully within the limits of the lands. These are the voices of the earth.

- We are called to a mutual responsibility between human beings and nature and to awaken the urgent need to heal our relationships with creation and with each other and to encourage others in our communities to do likewise.
- We are called to celebrate the Gift of Creation
- We are called to exercise our duty to support the poor developing countries most effected by climate change
- We are called to offer hope for a sustainable future for our young people into the future
- We are called to protect our soil and seas.

### Ordination

Pray for Rev Ronan Sheehan who will be ordained in his native parish of Newcestown, today Sunday 18<sup>th</sup>.

The annual collection for the Priesthood Education Fund in the Diocese will be taken up on weekend of 24<sup>th</sup>/25<sup>th</sup> September. This year two new students will begin studies for the Diocese of Cork and Ross at Valladolid in Spain and another candidate will begin studies for the Permanent Diaconate. The Priesthood Education Fund will finance their studies as well as costs for ongoing training and education of priests. In the region of €110,000 will be needed to meet these costs in the coming year. Last year €34,364 was raised in this collection so you are invited to be generous to the Priesthood Education Fund Collection this year.
