Season of Creation

The Season of Creation is the annual celebration of prayer and action, which is celebrated throughout the Christian world, for our Common Home.

Pope Francis established the 1st September as a World Day of Prayer for the Care of Creation.

This year the Season of Creation began on the 1st September and ends on the Feast of St Francis of Assisi, who is the patron saint of ecology, on the 4th October.

We are reminded in the Acts of the Apostles, Acts 17:28, that "It is in God's world we live and move and have our being."

This same theme is captured very well in Joseph Mary Plunkett's poem - *I See his Blood upon the Rose* - reminding us that God's presence is in the whole of creation.

I see his blood upon the rose,
And in the stars, the glory of his eyes.
His body gleams amid eternal snows.
His tears from the skies.
I see his face in every flower.
The thunder and the singing of the birds

Are but his voice.

And carven by his power, rocks are his written words.

All pathways by his feet are worn,

his strong heart stirs the ever-beating sea.

His crown of thorns is twined with every thorn

His cross is every tree.
