October month of the Missions

The theme of Mission month this year is "You shall be my witnesses." Mission Sunday or World Mission day will be celebrated on Sunday the 23rd of October.

The theme refers to the last conversation the Risen Jesus had with his disciples before he ascended into heaven. Jesus was about to send out the disciples to preach the Gospel but told them that not only were they to preach but also they were to be witnesses to the Gospel.

Pope Francis tells us that all Christians have an obligation to proclaim the Gospel and to be witnesses to Christ in the Gospel.

The Pope also reminds us that the Church's sole mission is to witness to Christ. We know that people are more likely to listen to witnesses than to preachers. Pope Francis reminds us of this many times in his encyclical "The Joy of the Gospel"

The Pope invites us all to support our missionaries all over the world where lay people, priests and religious serve the poorest of the poor and most vulnerable people.

We celebrate Mission Sunday by remembering all missionaries and supporting them by our prayers and financial contributions.
