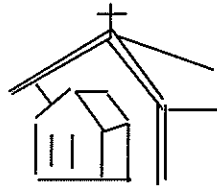

Programme on high profile G.A.A. player's recent visit to Kenya will be shown on T.G. 4 today, Sunday 15th at 5.30 pm.

The players had raised a lot of money and visited some of the projects they are funding. They played Hurling and Gaelic Football in Nairobi and planted a lot of trees. They visited Nairobi slums (Mercy Sisters), Agricultural projects (Franciscan Brothers), Hospitals, Health and Water Projects (Brighter Communities Worldwide). They also visited The High-Altitude Training Centre where Bro. Colm O'Connell from Mallow (Patrician Brother) trains many of the great Kenyan runners including David Rudisha – Double Olympic Champion and World Record Holder at 800 metres – who helped Bro. Colm to host the visitors.
