70th Anniversary of the Legion of Mary in Glanmire

This year we celebrate the 70th or Platinum Anniversary of the Legion of Mary in our Parish here in Glanmire.

The Praesidium in Glanmire is under the patronage of Our Lady of Lourdes.

Along with a group of Catholic women & Fr. Michael Tober, a priest of the Archdiocese of Dublin, Frank Duff formed the first praesidium of the Legion of Mary in Dublin, on 7th September 1921.

In the Legion Handbook, written in the main, by the Founder, Frank Duff, regarding the work of its members, it states:

"Members of a praesidium which is not engaged in some form of active work have no right to the name Legionaries of Mary."

"The Spirit of The Legion of Mary is Mary herself, her profound humility, perfect obedience, angelical sweetness, her heavenly wisdom, her spotless purity, her courageous love and her faith".

What happens at the Legion of Mary Meetings?

The meetings begin with opening prayers followed by the Rosary. A short spiritual reading is read and discussed at every meeting. Each week the members are asked to complete some work about which a report is given at the following meeting. The prayer intentions of people and the locality are remembered at the meeting.

What kind of work is done by Legionaries of Mary? The works of the Legion of Mary are categorised into what it calls the 3C's; Conversion, Conservation and Consolation.

In a further newsletter we will explore the works of the Legion of Mary.
