Reflection

The Presentation of the child Jesus in the Temple is a special feast day that is remembered every year on the 2nd of February. To emphasise its significance the Mass today begins with the special blessing of candles. This reminds us that the birth of Baby Jesus brought the Light of God into the world in the most significant and special way. When Mary and Joseph brought the baby Jesus to the temple which devout Jewish people did to thank God for the gift of their baby son, they met a very devout holy old man called Simeon who had been prompted to visit the temple that day at the same time because he knew precisely who Baby Jesus was and who he was going to grow up to be. Simeon knew immediately when he saw Baby Jesus that he was looking at God. He knew that Baby Jesus was the Messiah who would change the world when he grew up. Simeon also knew that Jesus would have all the experiences

of being human (good and bad) and that being God he would show us the best way to deal with suffering, temptation and evil.

Jubilee of Youth Pilgrimage to Rome Launch

Bishop Fintan will lead a group of fifty young people (18 to 30 years) to Rome this summer from the 28th July to the 4th August for **Jubilee of Youth Pilgrimage**. It is a once in a life opportunity for our young people to not only meet the Pope, to experience the Eternal City, but also to be encouraged and inspired as they meet other young people of faith from all continents.

Hundreds of thousands of young people are expected to travel and to experience this Jubilee Celebration, which only happens every twenty five years in the Church. The pilgrimage will cost €550 per person (plus fundraising) and will include seven nights half board at the Irish College, Travel Insurance, a 20Kg bag, and a pilgrim kit. There will be a special Launch Evening on Thursday 6th February at 7.30pm in Mardyke House (T12 W8RP).
